

Admission & Examination Rules

For the degree of

B. Sc. (Hons.) NURSING

Semester system



- 2. Medium of Instruction and Examination: English
- 3. Eligibility for admission: A candidate seeking admission to this course must have:
- (a) Passed 10+2 examination in science from Central Board of Secondary Education, or any other examination recognized by Jamia Hamdard as equivalent thereto, with at least 45% marks in the aggregate of Physics, Chemistry and Biology and must have passed in each of these subjects and English individually.
- (b) Qualified the admission test/interview conducted by Jamia Hamdard.
- (c) Attained the age of 17 years on 31st December of the year of admission. The maximum age limit for admission shall be 35 years.
- (d) Have the ability to communicate in English, Hindi or Urdu.
- (e) Have sound health.
- (f) Married candidates are also eligible for admission
- (g) Color blind candidates are eligible provided that colour corrected contact lens or spectacles are worn by such candidates.

Minimum provision of hostel accommodation for 30% of the total student's intake is compulsory for the institution.

Course structure

ne Rufaida College of Nursing follows the syllabus prescribed by Indian Nursing Council, thich has been duly approved by Academic Council of Jamia Hamdard. The distribution of iours in classroom instruction and supervised Nursing practice in various subjects is given below. The course contents are given in the Syllabus, as per semester system.

Odd Semester - 1st July to 31st December*

Even Semester - 1st January to 30th June*

Duration of the program: 8 semesters (4 years) i.

1-7 Semesters

One Semester Plan for the first 7 Semesters

Total Weeks per Semester: 26 weeks per semester

Number of Weeks/ Semester for instruction: 20 weeks (40 hours/ week × 20 weeks = 800 hours)

Number of Working Days: Minimum of 100 working days (5 days per week × 20 weeks)

Eighth semester – Internship: One semester = 22 weeks × 48 hours per week = 1056 hours
