1. In Semester I a new paper named Fundamentals of Biochemistry and September 2021. Biophysics will be taught at the departmental level and would be reframed, this will be of two credits only. Molecular Biology I, a new Course of two credits would also be introduced in the first semester.

Theory course entitled Biophysical and Biochemical techniques currently in the third semester will now be in the first semester. A new course has been introduced entitled Analysis and Visualization of genomic data in the third

3. Immunology has been shifted from the third to the second semester.

Molecular Biology in the second semester would be renamed as Molecular Biology II.
