- 1. Introduction of a new compulsory paper on the subject of Islamic Banking and Finance in M.A (Islamic Studies) Semester I, and Semester II in the academic year 2018-19 which would be continued henceforth since the condition of the availability of teacher is fulfilled now
- Changing few selected existing old papers of M.A (Islamic Studies) program of study into choice based
  papers to accommodate the new papers and forming new codes for the changed or introduced items
  (Details provided in the Annexure 1 to be given in the meeting).
- 3. Review of the shuffled papers of BAIS 204 (Computer Application) and BAIS 304 (Economics) in B.A (Hons.) Islamic Studies Semester 2 and 3 and reshuffling both the papers to the previous positions since that is not appropriately serving the requirement.

- 2.   - 3. Agenda item 3: The BOS reviewed the papers to be taught in B.A (Hons.) Islamic Studies and recommended to reshuffle paper BAIS-204 CA-I (Computer Applications) in Semester-II with Paper BAIS 304 EC-II (Economics) in Semester III (as that was before shuffling because the purpose is not being served appropriately with the earlier change) and accordingly changed the codes with effect from 2018-19; new codes are BAIS-204 EC-II (Economics) in Semester-II and Paper BAIS 304 CA-I (Computer Applications) in Semester III.
  - 4. Agenda item 4: On the matter of restricting the admission of *Madaris* students to B.A (Hons.) Islamic Studies program or Certificate or Diploma in Persian Language instead of direct admission in M.A (Islamic Studies), the BOS discussed and decided that the

- 5. Agenda item 5: The BOS authorized the HoD of Islamic Studies to revise the copy of By.

  5. Agenda item 5: The Programs of Study in the Department of Islamic Studies of By. Agenda item 5: The BOS authorized in the Department of Islamic Studies and also laws of the Programs of Study in the Department of By-Laws for the final also Laws of the Programs of Studies and also unanimously recommended to submit the revised copy of By-Laws for the final approval of the competent authorities.
- 6. Agenda item 6: The BOS resolved that Academic Council Resolution AC 30 (5) dated Agenda item of the Bob stated April 2016 (regarding the language of PhD theses in Islamic Studies), which stipulates April 2016 (regarding and stipulates that 'a thesis and its abstract should be written in English for submission,' should be that 'a thesis and its abstract should be written in English theses into English. modified because it requires translation of all non-English theses into English.
- Theses written in Urdu should be exempted from this rule and students may be allowed to submit these in Urdu for evaluation and award, because :
  - Urdu is an Indian language.
  - o It is a burden on Urdu-medium students (most of whom are from a madrasas and weak economic background) since it requires a huge investment in time and
  - o The quality of translation is often not up to the mark, resulting in loss of meaning and originality of the theses.
  - The PhD supervisor checks and can vouch for only the original Urdu thesis.
- · However, students writing their theses in Urdu are required to submit a Summary of the theses in English
- This matter may be placed before the AC, so that the regulations are changed in effect and students writing their theses in Urdu can submit the same without translation.
- 7. Agenda item 7: Under the last point 'Any other item for discussion', the BOS has discussed two things:
  - The BoS considered the case of PhD scholar Mr. Irshad Alam that he has carried out all his research work in Urdu and his registration will finally expire on 14 December 2018, he may be allowed to submit his thesis in Urdu. His case may be treated as emergency case and may be submitted for the final approval of the competent authorities
  - In the old copy of the By-Laws of M.A (Islamic Studies), no credits were given ii. for the Grand Viva-Voce, however, the BOS recommended to add 4 credits for the same and total credits of all subjects should be final 100 credits.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks by the Chair to all the BOS members present in the meeting meeting.
