The physiotherapy members of BOS also presented their suggestions along the same lines quoting examples of other eminent universities/ National Institutes of the country like NIOH, SVNIRTAR, AILPMR, PDDUNIPPD, and Santosh Medical College. The Delhi Council for Physiotherapy and Occupational Therapy (DCPTOT) has already mentioned in the list of deficiencies that there is no separate Department of Physiotherapy in the School of Nursing Sciences & Allied Health.

While Occupational therapy members agreed with renaming of "Department of physiotherapy and Occupational therapy". The house was of two opinions either it can be put forth for next BOS to take the input of Dr Smita Jayvant, Director, PDDUNIPPD, since it is a major decision or the matter may be decided by the standing committee.
