
Subject: Plagiarism Check – reg.

The Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Govt of India through INFLIBNET has given access to URKUND, a plagiarism detection software (PDS). It has been decided that all the theses/dissertations (UG/PG/MD/MPhil/PhD) submitted to Jamia Hamdard for award of degree will be subjected to plagiarism/similarity check by URKUND till the time there is another authorized plagiarism/similarity check software. With the new system 'receiver' and 'submitter' accounts have to be created by the Administrator. In this regard an e-mail will be required to be sent to Administrator (Advisor – Research) at sraisuddin@jamiahamdard.ac.in for creating 'receiver' (a supervisor/faculty) or 'submitter' (a scholar) account. A 'receiver' can submit the document as well as receive the report. However, a 'submitter' (a student) can only submit the document. He/she has to indicate the 'receiver' account while submitting the document for similarity check on URKUND portal. Supervisor and Scholar will submit a copy of the Plagiarism Check Certificate (as per format attached) along with screen shot of the report while submitting a thesis/dissertation in the Examination Section for evaluation.

It will be the responsibility of the supervisor/student to ensure compliance as per the University Grants Commission (Promotion of Academic Integrity and Prevention of Plagiarism in Higher Educational Institutions) Regulations, 2018 issued by Gazette Notification dated 23rd July, 2018 and they will be subject to action as notified in the UGC regulation. The notification is available at https://www.ugc.ac.in/pdfnews/7771545_academic-integrity-Regulation2018.pdf. As per the Regulation only Level 0 similarities upto 10% - (Minor similarities, no penalty) will be allowed. A separate order will be issued for creation of the Institutional Academic Integrity Panel (IAIP) and Departmental Academic Integrity Panel (DAIP) as per the provisions of the UGC Regulation.

The Similarity Check Certificate signed by Student, Supervisor and Librarian/Administrator shall be placed at the end of the thesis/dissertation. Teachers acting as Supervisor/Co-supervisor in the external thesis/dissertation of trainees/interns may also opt this practice.
