A free health camp was organized by Women Development Cell Jamia Hamdard in collaboration with Rehabilitation Centre, Dept. of Physiotherapy, Department of Moalajat, and Department of Food Technology, Jamia Hamdard on 12th June 2022, from 9:00 AM to 12:30 PM at Godhuli Senior Citizen Centre, New Gurudwara, E-Block, GK. II, New Delhi.

Prof. Yasmeen Shamsi, Dr. Md. Wasi Akhtar from SUMER, Dr. Sohrab Ahmad Khan (PT), Dr. Kalpana Zutshi (PT) and Dr. Hammad Ahmad Siddiqui (PT) from Rehabilitation Centre & Department of Physiotherapy along with students of SUMER, Physiotherapy department and Dept. of food technology attended the camp. In total, about 65 patients of various musculoskeletal disorders and other diseases like diabetes, hypertension etc. were examined and advised treatment accordingly. Initially the faculty members made the community members aware of the importance of health screening and how Physiotherapy and Unani Medicine can be useful to them. After registration each and every patient was screened for Blood Pressures, and attended by relevant consultant. Different exercises and manipulation therapy was offered to the patients suffering from different musculoskeletal disorders. Apart from consultation free Unani Medicines were also provided to the patient. The representatives from Department of Food Technology advised dietary regimen to patients suffering from Metabolic disorders. They were then asked and advised to visit the Majeedia Unani Hospital, and Rehabilitation Centre, Jamia Hamdard for the follow-up. It was a good outreach programme and community service for students of Jamia Hamdard. By the team work and holistic coordination, the health camp was a successful event.




















A Report on Health Camp

On the occasion of International Women's Day 2022, a **health camp** entitled "Orthopedic Health of the Women" was organized on 8th March 2022 by Women Development Cell, Jamia Hamdard at Majeedia Unani Hospital. Chief guest, Prof Dr. M Afshar Alam, Vice Chancellor Jamia Hamdard inaugurated the Health Camp with a ribbon cutting ceremony. Organizing Chairperson Prof Dr. Yasmin Shamsi greeted the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor with a bouquet.

Camp was jointly conducted by the Department of Moalajat, Department of Ilaj bit Tadbeer, School of Unani Medical Education and Research, Rehabilitation Centre and Majeedia Unani Hospital Jamia Hamdard. Regular running OPD's of Majeedia Unani Hospital also interceded for the execution of the camp. Nearly 70 patients, especially women suffering from bone and joint diseases were consulted for Health Check-up. Free consultation, medicines, Hijamah and medicated steam bath (Bukhoor) were provided in the camp. Patients were assessed, screened and counselled by Physiotherapists and Occupational therapists. Haemoglobin values and Blood sugar tests were also commenced free of cost. Registration of the patients started from 9:00 am-12:30 pm.

 - ✓ amongst the deprived population who have no access to basic healthcare services or knowledge about the diseases they are suffering from.
 - ✓ To teach them to deal with communicable and non-communicable

3. Context:

Unani Medicine is a comprehensive medical system, which meticulously deals with the various states of health and disease. It provides preventive, curative and rehabilitative healthcare. The fundamentals, prevention, diagnosis and treatment modalities of the system are based on scientific principles and holistic concepts of health and healing. Unani system of medicine plays an important role in health care delivery as its medicines are safe, cheaper and affordable to a common man. Unani medicines are safe and efficacious against various chronic and non-communicable diseases. It plays very important role in promotion of Health and prevention of Diseases.

Healthcare is a basic right of a human being and due to the poor and skyrocketing costs of healthcare system in our country, we need to contribute in improving the health care system by reaching to the poor and deprived people living in rural or urban areas with varieties of medical specialized services in the best interest of the patients.

4. The practice:

The free Medical health camps are regularly organized both by the departments of Unani Faculty as well as the attached Unani Majeedia Hoapital. The Faculty, hospital staff and students at PG and UD level are involved actively in these health care programmes. Medical camps are conducted to carry out health promotion, education, minor medical or surgical treatments and preventive healthcare services to deprived and poor community and in nearby rural areas. All the service activities at the camps are rendered free of charge to the attendees at the camp.

1. Title of the Practice:

Online Consultation by Unani Experts Of Jamia Hamdard.

2. Objectives of the Practice:

- 1. To provide healthcare to the needy people during the lockdown period.
- 2. To Popularize Unani Syatem of Medicine.
- 3. To provide training to the students to remotely handle the patients queries.
- 4. To generate awareness about Preventive Healthcare approaches of Unani Medicine to combat covid-19.
- 5. To Improve mental health status of community
- 6. To contribute to the government's efforts to combat covid-19.

3. The Context:

The Pandemic of Covid-19 pushed everyone inside their homes and nobody was able to seek proper health advice on general diseases other than Covid-19 during the lockdown phase. Therefore it was the need of hour to extend the healthcare advises directly to their homes without asking them to travel to the hospitals. Jamia Hamdard provided an online platform to the people of country to consult the experts of Unani System of Medicine for their ailments.

4. The Practice:

- A group of experts of Unani Medicine were engaged to provide online consultation to the patients who were unable to travel to the OPDs of hospital due to covid related restrictions or on account of fear of getting covid while travelling to the hospital.
- A dedicated mobile number was allocated to the online consultation which was propagated to the people through social media platforms like WhatsApp, Twitter, Facebook and Instagram etc.
- The patients were able to talk to the Unani Experts on their health issues and seek the guidance to take care their health by using lifestyle modifications, diet managements and use of herbs of medicinal values available at home.
- Video Calls were enabled for one-to-one discussion and to enable the consultants to diagnose the problem and to guide the patients accordingly.
- Through WhatsApp messaging patients were facilitated round the clock 24x7.

5. Evidence of Success:

• As an outcome of the initiative around 500 patients were successfully treated and provided health advises.

6. Problems Encountered & Resources Required:

Sometimes availability of the medicines in the reach of patients was the major problem due to lockdown. Unawareness of use of online platforms to download prescriptions and non-availability of the supported apps was another issue which was encountered during the activity. Poor network connectivity was also a problem.



A REPORT ON FREE HEALTH CAMP 20th MARCH 2022



A free health camp was organized by the Department of Physiotherapy at Tara Apartments, Alaknanda on 20th March 2022 between 9 am to 1 pm. Dr Nishat Quddus, Head, Department of Physiotherapy, Dr. Sohrab Ahmad Khan, organizing secretary of the health camp and Superintendent Rehabilitation Centre, Dr Deepak Malhotra, Deputy Superintendent, Rehabilitation Centre, Dr Kalpana Zutshi, Associate Professor, Dr Sahar Zaidi, Assistant Professor, along with students of the Physiotherapy department screened more than 45 residents of Tara Apartments for various musculoskeletal ailments and provided them advise on posture correction and lifestyle modifications. Initially the faculty members made the community members aware of the importance of health screening and how Physiotherapy can be useful to them. The residents underwent a registration for health camp followed by filling up of a basic Assessment Performa after which each one of them was individually assessed and advised according to their concerned chief complaint. They were then advised to visit the Rehabilitation Centre at Jamia Hamdard, where all physiotherapy services are available. There was full cooperation from the President, Tara Cooperative Group Housing Society, Alaknanda and Ms Seema Rani (Cultural Coordinator, Jamia Hamdard). It was an interesting community service activity for students of the Physiotherapy department as well. Future health camps in nearby localities are also in pipeline. KOCHI: Kerala is lending a helping hand to the rehabilitation of sex workers in GB Road, a red-light area in Delhi. Distress Management Collective India (DMCI), an NGO in Delhi led by Keralites, is buying masks manufactured by rehabilitated sex workers and distributing them among deprived people in

the state.

Gitanjali Babbar, founder, director of Kat-Katha, an NGO that works among sex workers said: "Social distancing and other restrictions have left the sex workers jobless." "At least a few of them are ready to abandon sex work. In the past one year we could rehabilitate the maximum number of sex workers, said Babbar, who had been working for the welfare of sex name/articleshow/92691317.cms) workers for more than a decade.

"Rehabilitation of sex workers can't be done in a few days, rather it would take three or four years. Post-lockdown 23 women sex workers have come out of the brothels in GB Road. We will have to train them and provide them with alternative livelihoods. Otherwise, they would return to the kotha (brothel)," Babbar said. According to her, training

them in mask making was the first step. "We plan to train them in whatever job they are interested in. If more people buy the masks made by these women, it would be a great help for their rehabilitation," Babbar said.

The DMCI supports Kat-Katha by undertaking the distribution of masks. "We will be sending a consignment of 30,000 masks to Kerala in a few days," Sakhi John, executive committee member of DMCI, said.

The DMCI with Justice <u>Kurian Joseph</u> as the chief patron also provides education to the <u>street children</u> in Delhi. "The children of the sex workers in the Kothas on GB Road are deprived of education, nutritious food, and other facilities. We give informal education to them. We could enroll a few in schools in 2019," said Sakhi John.

At least 30,000 masks made by rehabilitated sex workers of GB Road, Delhi, will reach Kerala soon



KOCHI: Ernakulam on Sunday recorded 1,807 Covid positive cases, including 1,747 contact ones, with a TPR of 17.45%. Source of infection in 14 cases are unknown. Most cases of the day were reported from Kottuvally (151) followed by Edavanakkad (85), Pallippuram (80) and Thrikkakara (74). West Kochi alone reported 124 cases. As many as 11 guest workers are also among the positive cases.

Less than five cases were reported from 33 places in the district. As many as 1,936 persons recovered on Sunday when 287 were discharged. While 242 were lodged in hospitals and other treatment centres.

The number of patients undergoing treatment at hospitals and at houses touched 20,257 on Sunday. Of the total, 144 are in Government Medical College Hospital, Ernakulam, 1,448 in private hospitals and the rest in Covid first and second-line treatment centres, houses and other government hospitals. A total of 10,355 samples were sent for testing from both the government and private sectors together. As many as 56,088 people are under quarantine in Ernakulam.

Meanwhile, Mission Covid district campaign of Kudumbashree started in Ernakulam. Under the initiative, all Kudumbashree workers and their family members will be sensitized on Covid preventive measures. Around three lakh families in Ernakulam are associated with Kudumbashree.

restrictions.



Running away in Covid times

The officials said some of the children travelled without food for two to three days and had reached the city hiding out of the sight of the railway police on trains.

"Some of them suffer from mental disorders. As Ernakulam is the last point of some of the trains from the north east, the runaway children end up here and we rescue them. On asking why they left home, many won't reveal the reason. They start talking once they are lodged in care homes," said an official with the child helpdesk, which rescues children reaching <u>Aluva</u>, Ernakulam town and Ernakulam junction railway stations.

"Of the 20 children, four were rescued along with their mothers who were forced to leave their homes due to domestic

abuse. In some cases, the children were in unsafe conditions as their mothers were found to be suffering from mental health problems, said the official.

"We produce the children before the child welfare committee and it sends them to the care home and initiates steps to send them back with assistance from the child welfare committees in their home districts," he added.

In some cases the parents themselves approach the child welfare committees after coming to know about the whereabouts of their children. "Some may be too poor even to buy the train tickets to <u>Kerala</u>. In such cases, we book tickets for them." the official said.

Though personnel belonging to the railway protection force conduct inspections in moving trains, many of these children go unnoticed as they might be sleeping on berths. The official said in some cases they will have to convince the children that they are there to rescue them and not to harm and only then they will go with them.

- 2. How to prevent medication problems in polypharmacy-importance of gap timing.
- 3. Information about the OTC medication Strategies, not to take OTC medications without consulting doctors, their harmful effects.
- 4. Counseled about Adverse Drug Reactions (ADRs)- Adverse drug reaction can be defined as any noxious unintended and undesired effects of a drug that occur at. doses used for prevention, diagnosis or treatment or it is an unwanted or harmful reaction. Examples of such adverse drug reactions include rashes, jaundice, anemia, a decrease in the white blood cell count, kidney damage, and nerve injury that may impair vision or hearing.
- 5. Patients were told that the "ADRs can be reported via PvPI helpline number (18001803024) on weekdays from 9:00 am to 5:30 pm."

At the end of the day managed to create awareness about prescription, medication regimen, importance of OTC medication, risks of self-medication & about ADRs and their importance.

Report: National Pharmacovigilance Week (September 17-23, 2021) Celebration by the Department Of Pharmacology, SPER Jamia Hamdard

The Commission (The Indian Pharmacopoeia National Coordination Centre for Pharmacovigilance Programme of India (NCC-PvPI)) initiated the annual celebration of the National Pharmacovigilance Week from this year from 17th-23rd September. The theme of the first National Pharmacovigilance Week was "Pharmacovigilance: A step towards Patient Safety". In line with the mandate of PCI & PVPI the Department of Pharmacology, School of Pharmaceutical Education & Research, Jamia Hamdard celebrated **National** the Pharmacovigilance Week with full zeal and enthusiasm.

Amid the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic, a combination of virtual and physical activities was planned by the department for the celebration of National Pharmacovigilance Week. The inaugural session of the National Pharmacovigilance Week celebration was commenced on 17th September 2021 with an orientation lecture by the Head of the Department Prof. (Dr.) Abul Kalam Najmi on the topic Pharmacovigilance: Need of The Hour". The Department collaborated with an NGO Miracles Happen Foundation (registered under company Sec 8) working in public health domain for social outreach. The objectives of the collaboration were

- To spread the awareness of adverse affects due to OTC medicine.
- To access the adverse event and adverse drug reactions associated with ongoing drug therapy and vaccine administration.
- To conduct a survey regarding cases of self administration of medicines without consultation.
- Door to door campaign to promote adverse drug reaction reporting to improve patient safety.
- Sensitizing pharmacists working in pharmacy stores about importance of adverse drug reaction reporting.

M. Pharm Pharmacy Practice 3rd Semester postgraduate students actively participated in this campaign and it turned out to be an element of learning the art of pharmacy practice. More than 200 prescriptions were reviewed, patients were counseled at their home and around 50

pharmacists in Pharmacies of nearby areas like Sangam Vihar, Tughlakabad, Alkananda, Kalkaji, Govindpuri, Okhla and Lajpa tnagar were sensitized for Pharmacovigilance.

A poster competition for undergraduate and postgraduate students of Pharmacy was also organized by the department. The theme of the poster competition was "Pharmacovigilance: A step towards Patient Safety". We received overwhelming response of the students. A panel of the three professors of the department evaluated the posters and the best poster was shared with the NCC-PvPI.

And continuing the celebration of the National Pharmacovigilance Week, the Valedictory Session on 23rd September 2021 was conducted taking in consideration the job perspective of pharmacovigilance for pharmacy students. In the gracious presence of the Vice Chancellor, Jamia Hamdard, Prof. Afshar Alam, Dean School of Pharmaceutical Education & Research (SPER) Prof. Vidhu Aeri and Head Department Of Pharmacology Prof. Abul Kalam Najmi, a lecture on the topic "Industry Perspective on Pharmacovigilance" was delivered by the distinguished and prominent figure of Pharmacovigilance Industry Dr Moin Don. The event was attended digitally by students and academia across India. He not only explained the importance of Pharmacovigilance in the industry but also motivated and guided the students about the carrier opportunities in the field of Pharmacovigilance. The weeklong celebration of the National Pharmacovigilance Week was concluded with the felicitation ceremony. The inducing and inspirational words of Prof. Vidhu Aeri (Dean, SPER) and motivational speech of Prof. Abul Kalam Najmi (Head, Department Of Pharmacology) imparted students a vision to strengthen their knowledge for a bright future.









RX HEALTH CAMP 2017 (22 and 23 March, 2017) Dept. of Pharmacology, SPER

The Department of Pharmacology, SPER organized a two-day health camp on 22 and 23 March 2017 in remembrance of Late Hakeem Abdul Hameed, the founder of Jamia Hamdard during the annual fest of the School of Pharmaceutical Education and Research "Rx". The camp was organized in collaboration with the School of Unani Medical Education and Research and Rotary Blood Bank. The camp was inaugurated by Mr. Firdaus Wani, the Registrar of the Jamia Hamdard. . The camp was exclusively organized for poor people living in nearby areas, for the students and staff of the Jamia Hamdard. The camp was divided into three verticals. The first vertical had a blood donation camp, vaccination program, physiotherapy session, and IFFCO TOKIO health insurance policy information center. Rotary blood bank came up with their mobile bus facility for blood donation. 50 donors turned up to donate their valuable blood. In Hepatitis b vaccination program, 25 people from the economically weaker background were given first vaccination and remaining two booster doses were given at the specified time intervals. The second vertical was for full body checkups and free pathological tests. Hematological tests (Kidney Function Test and Liver Function Tests), blood pressure monitoring, blood group determination, body mass index, random blood sugar test, and spirometry (PFT) were done. In the third vertical all the awareness and counseling sessions were included. Different stalls were set up for various awareness programs that included Women's health awareness on cervical cancer, anemia, osteoarthritis, breast cancer (method of self-examination), smoking cessation & alcohol abuse, antibiotics use antibiotics resistance awareness, lifestyle modification for metabolic disorders. More than 300 people benefited from the camp. Postgraduate, Undergraduate, and Diploma students of SPER actively participated in the camp. Mr. Ibraheem Hussain, Ms. Gulnaz Bano, Rustam Ekbbal, Mr. Shamshuddin, and Mr. Nadeem PhD and m Pharm Scholars of Dept. of Pharmacology were student coordinators. The camp was concluded on 23 March 2017 with the vote of thanks by Prof. Abul Kalam Najmi, the Faculty In-charge of the camp.



Women Health Camp: SEHAT (18-10-2020) Dept. of Pharmacology, SPER

After lifting of the lockdown in the midst of 2020, a health camp "SEHAT" for women was organized on October 18, 2020. Women are more delicate to their health and more prone to suffer from bone disease and iron deficiency. During the lockdown, women's health and nutrition were the least taken care of, especially women from lower-income strata. Keeping that in mind, students of Pharmacy Practice, Dept. of Pharmacology, SPER, Jamia Hamdard organized a one-day free health camp for women in the Noor Nagar slum area. In this camp free check-ups were provided, more than 100 women were screened for bone density, calcium deficiency, and nutrition distribution assessment. In addition, free medicines were provided to the women. The camp received an overwhelming response from the people. Prof. Abul kalam Najmi, the faculty incharge of the camp thanked all the volunteers for their enthusiastic participation.











Diabetes Screening Camp in Rural Areas: Aarogya (23-07-2021) Dept. of Pharmacology, SPER

The Department of Pharmacology, SPER, Jamia Hamdard in collaboration with the Miracles Happen foundation, organized a diabetic screening and awareness health camp on 23 July 2021 at Sunderwal village of Lakhimpur district, Uttar Pradesh. The health camp started at 11 am at the Royal polyclinic of Sunderwal. Parameters like body mass index, blood pressure, and blood glucose were estimated to screen villagers for diabetes mellitus. For people having blood glucose levels above the normal range, confirmatory blood tests at a very nominal price were arranged. Those who were already on hypoglycemic drugs were counseled regarding the lifestyle medication and drug therapy. Patients with altered findings and poor adherence to the old treatment were referred to higher centers for further need. Non-adherence to the drug regimen was the major problem owing to the cost of the pharmacotherapy. Total 85 villagers turned up for the health checkup. Free medicines for the general ailment, were distributed. It was the first of its kind camp in the area.

7. Fit India Youth Club (4 September 2020)




8. CELEBRATION OF CONSTITUTION DAY 2020



Jamia Hamdard's Department of Rehabilitation Sciences organized a national level webinar on "Mental Health Issues in COVID-19 Pandemic" on 20th May 2020, aiming to create awareness about potential stressors triggered during the pandemic in community and to provide strategies to cope with the potential stressors under the current challenge of COVID-19 and the lockdown.

The webinar got an overwhelming response with more than 900 registrants from all over the country and some of the international delegates from Saudi Arabia, Riyadh and Nigeria also registered for it. Keeping in consideration such an overwhelming response, it was hosted both on the google meet platform and was also streamed live on YouTube. As per an analysis the webinar got 250 participants on google meet and a total view of 800 participants from all around the world on live streaming.

The resource person for the webinar, Prof. R.C. Jiloha, recipient of several national and international academic awards of high repute, is a psychiatrist with over 40 years of professional experience as a clinician and a medical teacher. Dr. Jiloha conducted the whole session in a very efficient manner. He gave valuable insights on the various mental health issues and stressors in COVID-19 pandemic. He emphasized that COVID-19 pandemic is spreading worldwide; a parallel epidemic of fears and worries is spreading in the countries that are progressively hit by the virus. No doubt, public health measures like social distancing quarantine and isolation are beneficial in bringing down the growth of infection, they cause adverse effects on mental health of every one including the affected people. Lockdown, a form of forced isolation, takes away what people need most in times of great distress—warmth, support, closeness, presence of someone around and collective meaning-making of the uncalled-for situation. He also focused on Mental health problems, as public scare, fears and anxieties. These conditions manifest as anxieties over touching any potentially infected surface, meeting a person with a travel history, involving visit to highly infected places, or developing any signs or symptoms of upper respiratory tract infections like coughing, sneezing, fever etc. There is paranoia and fear if any other person sneezes or coughs in the vicinity. While these mental health fears and anxieties are likely to be mild and short lived, long-term mental health effects are inevitable. Most vulnerable are the frontline healthcare workers, affected patients, people in quarantine and isolation, children, pregnant women, diagnosed mentally ill, homeless and the elderly. He also explained the different strategies to cope with anxiety, motivational issues, other potential stressors under the current challenge of COVID-19. After the completion of the session, there was an interactive session between the expert and the participants where Dr. Jiloha resolved the queries raised by the participants.
