CHIDELINES-

- · Should be self-explanatory.
- · Text should be neat with font size 26.
- · The poster content should be evidence based
- File Format should be Power Point (ppt/pptx), JPEG
- and pdf. · Use of graphs, tables, images (evidence based) will be preferred.
- · One student can submit only one poster.
- · Poster Dimensions: 3 ft × 4 ft.
- · Posters apart from the above topics and without proper dimensions and format will be rejected.

TOPIC FOR ESSAY:

- 1. COVID-19 Pandemic: Challenges & strategies in Education.
- 2. Post COVID-19 Pandemic: The New Normal

GUIDELINES:

- Language may be English or Hindi (Should not be a mixture of both).
- Word limit should not exceed 1500 words. (Essays exceeding the word limit will be rejected).
- Use of pictures and graphs should not be more than 2.
 In case of use of any data / graph / picture in the essay, must mention the evidence/references with it.
- Font should be Times New Roman Font size 12; with line spacing 1.5.
 Essay should be uploaded only in .pdf and .doc file.
 Essays apart from the above topics will be rejected.
