This policy will provide guidelines to ensure that the educational program (curriculum), Pos and COs at Jamia Hamdard is based on an approved learning framework as suggested by UGC , AICTE, MCI, PCI.

Objectives

- Effective implementation of measures for quality improvement as per the quality mandate of UGC and recommendations of accreditation bodies
- The graduate outcomes shall be such that a minimum of 50% of the graduating students secure access to employment /self-employment or engage in the pursuit of Higher education.
- Promote the linkage of the students with the society/industry such that at least two-third of these students engage in socially productive activities during their period of study in the institution.
- Train the students in essential professional skills such as teamwork, communication skills, leadership skills, time management skills, soft skills and inculcate a spirit of innovation /entrepreneurship and critical thinking among the students and promote avenues for the display of these talents.
- Conduct regular induction programs for students
- Ensure that at least half of the students passing out appear for examinations such as GATE/JAM/UGC-NET, and at least half of those appearing qualify
- Tracking the student progression after completing the course.
- Use ICT-based learning tools for an effective teaching-learning process.
- Adopt Choice-based credit system and academic flexibility for interdisciplinary learning.
- Adopt LOCF and revise the curriculum at regular intervals
- Adoption of SWAYAM –MOOCs courses
- Adopt NEP-2020
