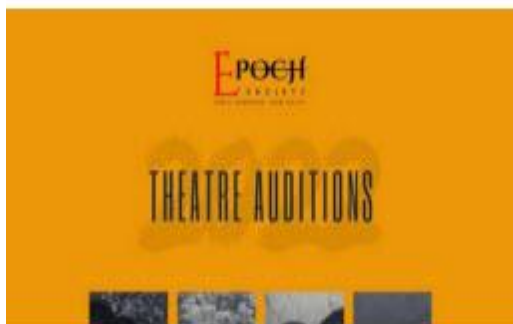
The best speakers were Mohd. Saif Ahmed and Ananya Mohan.
