# [SESSION 1]: Patent Filing Procedures: Domestic and Overseas [approx. 30min.]

It is noteworthy that 60% of the patent applications are rejected as they fail to meet basic procedural requirements which include poor drafting of specification and claim, improper management of deadlines, and non substantiated communication with patent agents and patent offices. Can (and should) we do anything to change things? The panel will discuss about the procedures of disclosing, drafting, reading, and filing.

# [SESSION 2]: Understanding the R&D workflow and possibility to incorporate IPR Policy within an organization and their benefits [approx. 30min.]

R&D in itself is rigorous exercise involving a number of stages, which includes conceptualization, experimentation/study, analysis of the outcomes and most of the time ends in a publication. Slight moderation of the traditional flow of work and incorporation of IP as a concept can result into commercially successful innovations. The panel will discuss importance of patent protection over publication.

# [SESSION 3]: Technology Transfer aspect and their roadmap for proliferation of an organization [approx.30min.]

The aim of IP protection is 'Growth & Development' by minimizing competitive by acquiring monopolistic rights. However, unless such rights are utilized fully, they result into overhead expenditure as the maintenance cost of an IP inventory is high. One should consider portfolio pruning in order to maintain a balance. Licensing out, sell/spin-off, assignments are some of the options available for effective monetization of IPRs. The panel will discuss various aspects related to IP portfolio management.

# [SESSION 4]: Group Discussion and Knowledge Sharing [approx. 30min.]

Ignorance or even lack of awareness is never an excuse in Legal & IPR domains. To be in the competition, it is always required to be more aware and more knowledgeable. The panel will discuss various issues relating to IPR with participants and share mutual experience and knowledge in related field.






